## DID YOU KNOW...

- » Concordia opened the George R. White Library & Learning Center in fall 2009. The 74,000 sq. ft. center is the hub of campus with expanded library resources, classrooms, faculty offices, community meeting spaces, important centers of learning, and a coffee house.
- » For the past two years Concordia was named to the U.S. President's Higher Education Community Service Honor Roll for exemplary service efforts and service to America's communities. On average, Concordia's faculty, staff, and students contribute more than 223,000 hours of practicum, internship, and service learning hours per year serving over 10,000 community members, 5,000 of which are youth.
- » Concordia University is the most ethnically diverse private university in Oregon.
- » Our nursing graduates rank among the highest in the state of Oregon on the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX).
- » Concordia Place Apartments, a modern residence hall, was completed in summer 2009. The 50,000 sq. ft. building features 43 apartment-style units with kitchens and bathrooms. Common spaces, bike storage, on-site parking, and other amenities make the new residence hall a comfortable place to live and learn.
- » Concordia is ranked as one of the top 10 athletic departments in the nation according to the NAIA Directors' Cup Standings and has produced 182 All-Americans, 116 Academic All-Americans, 41 Cascade Collegiate Conference Championships, and 13 Individual National Champions.
- » "Concordia University is at the head of the class for community engagement. Concordia connects campus and community like no other. It's a place where students serve the community and, in the process, become servant leaders." Tom Potter, Mayor, City of Portland, 2005-08.
- » Concordia students and faculty contributed 500 hours to prepare 80 tax returns and generated \$122,078.00 in state and federal refunds to local residents in need of tax assistance.
- » Concordia University's state-of-the art Throw Center is utilized by Olympic and Concordia student-athletes for training. Inspired by Concordia coach and Olympic gold medalist, Mac Wilkins, Concordia's Throw Center is one-of-a-kind in the U.S. and is available to student and local youth from around the region.
- » The Concordia Teacher Corps, established in 2006, is a select group of Concordia student volunteers who mentor and tutor elementary, middle, and high school students at nearby neighborhood schools.
- » Concordia University is home to the Richard Paul & Jane Roe Shakespeare Authorship Research Centre. The only one of its kind in the world, the Centre attracts educators, students, and scholars from around the globe who pursue one of the great literary questions of our time: who created the poetic and dramatic works attributed to William Shakespeare?
- » Concordia University School of Law, located in downtown Boise, Idaho, is anticipated to open in fall 2011.
- » Concordia University is now home to the Wholistic Peace Institute–Nobel Peace Laureate Program.
